I. Attendance and Introductions

The meeting was called to order by President Tom Parshall 7:25.

II. Approval of minutes from August 8, 2011 meeting

III. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Shyrl Cone reported on the findings of the Audit Committee. They had reported that the savings was listed under income and expense and that should be changed. Reconcile with bank statements using Quicken. Amounts of spending were fine; committee had Shyrl report on this. Nothing glaring stood out in their report, and only suggestions were made for Streamlining. They suggested a paper trail of receipts for the use of petty cash from museum gift shop sales. Tom stated that we met IRS requirements. A Treasurer's report will be given in October.

Diana volunteered to make signs if provided with a list of displays. Hildy reports that we have good docents, including Margaret Melville, Donna Bulloch, Bill McEachen, Diana Wells, and Barbara Krueger. Hildy also emphasized that she be listed as the person to talk to regarding being a docent and working at the museum. She also reported that donations have been good.

VI. Heritage Day Planning

The museum will be open from 10:00 to 4:00. A scarecrow for Heritage Day is on the porch.

VII. Board Member Drive

There was a discussion where possible new board members were mentioned and present board members were encouraged to up recruitment efforts.

VIII. Front Sign Change

Tom will put side rails on the front sign to be used to post changing museum hours and other Information.

Comments from the Board

Fund raising methods were discussed including asking local businesses to put donation jars by their cash registers. It was suggested that a sign be put in the Historical Society/Museum display case at the township hall posting hours the museum is open. A new frame for the photo portrait of Florence Dearing was requested. Mike said that something needed to be done about bats getting in around the chimney. Bill McEachen will help Hildy with the postal displays on Wednesday.
